## OSHA HAZWOPER Training

### 40-Hour HAZWOPER (CSHW40HR)

4.0 CEU Credits

The OSHA HAZWOPER 40-Hour Course provides training for workers, managers and supervisors working at a hazardous waste operations and emergency response (HAZWOPER) sites. OSHA considers training an important component for maintaining job site safety.



### 24-Hour HAZWOPER (CSHW24HR)

2.4 CEU Credits

The ClickSafety HAZWOPER 24-Hour online training course is intended to meet the classroom training requirements in OSHA standard 29 CFR 1910.120 for workers on a regulated site who have limited exposure to hazardous substances, but may still participate in clean-up operations, operations involving hazardous waste at a facility or controlled emergency response operations.

### 8-Hour HAZWOPER Refresher (CSHAZREF)

0.8 CEU Credits

HAZWOPER Refresher is an annual 8-hour OSHA certificate-level recertification course in Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response (HAZWOPER).

HAZWOPER Refresher is an annual 8-hour OSHA certificate-level recertification course in Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response (HAZWOPER).
